Have you heard? There's a movement starting. A movement that beckons all who will take up the challenge. But it is a movement that could have an eternal impact in one, if not many more lives.

It's called "Who's Your One?" And it's a movement that is being established by the North American Mission Board and the President of our Southern Baptist Convention. The movement is founded upon one simple question: What if every believer took one person – just one – and prayed for them, shared the gospel with them, and discipled them this year. It could be a family member, a neighbor, a co-worker, or someone you see on a regular basis (think grocery store clerk, gas station clerk, classmate, etc.).

Here's a description of the heart of the movement from their website: Imagine if every believer could answer that question with the name of a person who is far from God—a person for whom they're praying and with whom seeking to share the gospel. That's the intention behind Who's Your One. We believe God's people don't merely need another method for evangelism— what they need is a white-hot passion to see people who are far from God experience the new life He offers through Jesus Christ.

It's a call to take personal ownership of the Great Commission that Jesus gave us. It's a challenge to be responsible for just one life, one person whom needs to hear God's good news and be taught how to follow Him. At times, the task before the church to reach the nations can seem overwhelming and too complex. But what if every Christ follower just focused on one. How might it change our church? Our state? Our convention?

I have been participating as an adult sponsor at a local middle school club where we have been learning this year about the disciples and what it means to follow Christ. Recently, we talked about Andrew, a disciple who is not mentioned much in the Scriptures like some of the more famous disciples. But, every time Andrew is mentioned, he is bringing one person to Jesus, and one of those that he brought was Peter, his brother, who would later confess the identity of Jesus, the Messiah, and become the leader of the early church. Imagine if Andrew would have never embraced the desire to reach his one; where might Peter have ended up?



I wanted to let everyone know what is going on in my journey with cancer. I have been accepted to participate in the clinical trial at MD Anderson in Houston. We are leaving Saturday, taking 3 days to get there

this time. My appointments start on Tuesday, Wednesday is my busiest day, Thursday I see Dr. Jazaeri and have my first infusion.

The trial involves immunotherapy. I will given 2 drugs duvalumab and tremelimumab administered in combination versus sequentially. The group I am place in is randomly selected.

We are excited about being chosen and believe this is God's plan.

Pray for few side effects and a reasonable place to stay. At this time we plan to be gone 5 weeks, during this time I will have 2 infusions. I will have 13 cycles, each one is Frank & Dottie Shealy 28 days.
